The 9-ball league is handicapped based on the total team average of both teams. You add up each players average that is playing that night to come up with a total team average. Then you take the difference and the team with the lower average gets that many points per round. To get a truer average of each player we will be calculating the averages after the 3rd week of play and re-calculating the league with the handicap points for each week already played.

There is a point system for certain balls. One (1) point each for the 1,3,5,7 and six (6) points for the 9-ball for a total of 10 points. If you shoot and make one of the "point" balls, but then scratch the cue ball, the point goes to your opponent. If you make a 9-ball on the break and don't scratch, then you get all 10 points. Make sure to mark that it was a 9-ball break. If you make the 9-ball and scratch, then you just spot the 10-ball or higher and your opponent gets ball-in-hand.
